

Terms and Conditions

Old Sefter School Holiday Accommodation

Bookings for the accommodation are accepted subject to availability and should be confirmed by telephone or email. A 30% non-refundable deposit is required to secure the booking. If possible please pay with PayPal to sefterschool@btinternet.com (no PayPal account is required to do this) or by cheque made payable to D Stevens.

The balance of the tariff must be paid 8 weeks (60 days) before date of arrival. Non-payment of the balance by the due date shall be construed as a cancellation by the Client. We do not issue reminders as the date the balance is due is clearly stated on the invoice issued at the time the booking is confirmed.

A cancellation must be advised as soon as possible, and every effort will be made to re-let the holiday accommodation. For cancellations made by the Client within two weeks of the arrival date, the entire amount will be forfeit. We strongly recommend you insure against cancellation. The deposit is non-returnable.

All bookings are from 3pm on the day of arrival until 10am on the day of departure.

The person signing the booking form certifies that he or she is authorised to agree the terms and conditions on behalf of all persons in the party. The maximum number of guests allowed is **two**.

We must ask you to report and pay for any damage or breakages that occur during your stay. Towels supplied are strictly for use in the holiday accommodation and are not supplied for beach use. Guests are asked to leave the accommodation clean and tidy when vacating.

We operate a **STRICT NO SMOKING and NO PETS POLICY**, except for guide dogs.

Whilst every care is taken to ensure that our web site and literature are correct the proprietors cannot be held liable for any changes or alterations made. The proprietors are relieved of any liability from accidents to guests and any loss or damage to property.

It is the intention of the proprietors that Old Sefter School provides a relaxing holiday environment. The proprietors reserve the right to decline accommodation. The proprietors are entitled to reasonable access to the accommodation.
